Decide: when your pet will travel

Decide: where your pet will travel

Know:

- a) The basics (see [Pet Travel - General Advanced Preparation](#))
- b) That Veterinary procedures could start up to 7 months in advance for some countries (see [Export from UAE - Destination Country Information](#))
- c) That final flight booking can only be made a week or so before departure.
- d) That flawed paperwork or procedures will result in flight delay or cancellation

Know:

- a) Entry requirements of the destination country and
- b) When they must be performed. (See [Export from UAE - Destination Country Data](#))

Get the right size cage (see [Pet Travel - Measure pet / size of cage](#)) of IATA approved design

Know the costs to make sure you are financially prepared for pet shipping.

- b) Add estimated freight charges to arrangement fees. Airlines can quote for you, depending on cage size.
